SCI AmeriCorps – Youth Leadership Coordinator

The SCI AmeriCorps program supports youth success by connecting young people with the relationships, experiences, and resources they need to succeed. Members implement volunteer outreach and capacity building activities that increase volunteer participation, and provide leadership training and service-learning opportunities for youth. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites in Greater Boston, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc.

SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Youth Leadership Coordinator positions for a 1700-hour service commitment between September 2021 and June 2022. The YLC will increase the capacity of host sites to implement social capital building, youth engagement and community service-learning as strategies to achieve high educational outcomes.

HOST SITE OPPORTUNITY – Milford Youth Center (Milford, MA)

The SCI AmeriCorps member will:

- Create and implement programs at the Milford Youth Center (MYC) after school program
- Maintain and expand the current MYC youth council
- Enhance civic leadership skills by recruiting and engaging youth in community service-learning projects
- Engage youth in collaboration with the local television studio to take part in local events as well as learn how to use equipment and edit film
- Engage youth to participate in the annual events like our "Dressed up, Not Messed Up" fashion show, Halloween event, etc.

REQUIREMENTS

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
- *Availability to serve in-person for on-site programming. Access to a car required.*

- Receive a Taxable Stipend up to \$15,000/year, paid bi-weekly
- Earn a Federal Education Award worth \$6000+ on successful completion of service
- Professional Development Trainings
- Eligible for Free Health Care at a no cost premium
- Can receive Student Loan Forbearance during active service
