What's Happening Now at the Town Clerk's Office:

ELECTIONS: The Annual Town Election is April 2, 2024

Sample Ballots are on the Town website www.milfordma.gov.

Deadline to Register to Vote was March 23rd (10 days before election)

Options for Voting:

Early Voting by Mail- application deadline is March 26th

There is NO Early Voting IN PERSON for this election.

Election Day Voting- Polls will be open at all normal polling locations from 7am until 8pm.

Pr. 1 & Pr. 6- Milford Senior Center, 60 North Bow St.

Pr. 2 & Pr. 3- Italian American Veterans Hall, 4 Hayward Field

Pr. 4, Pr. 5, Pr. 7, Pr. 8- Milford Portuguese Club, 119 Prospect Heights

Town Meeting Members

Precincts 1-8- Ten seats 3 yr. terms (top 10 vote getters in will fill seats) Winners will be notified by MAIL.

Pr. 3 – Two open seats, 1 yr. seat

Pr. 4 – Five open seats, 1 yr. term

Pr. 5- One open seat, 1 yr. term

We, as registered voters are the ones who elect our Select Board, School Committee, Board of Health, Board of Assessors, Park Commission and Town Meeting members (to name a few). The By-Laws by which our Town is governed and the issues that directly affect our homes, properties, schools, parks, roads and the safety and well being of our town is decided upon by those we elect.

Keep in mind that these elected officials are human and no human is perfect. Cast your vote because you are satisfied or dissatisfied with the job they have been elected to do.



Do not let the "decision" be made for you. Let your voice be heard and VOTE on April 2nd!

Dog Licenses:

Dog licenses are issued at the Town Clerk's Office. Our licensing period runs from April 1st - June 30th each year. If you return the insert portion in the Annual Street Listing to register your dog, we will hold the form until April 1st to do so. Please make sure to send a valid rabies certificate to our office either by mail or email to MLaughlin@townofmilford.com. If you have a new puppy/dog, please register the puppy/dog after it receives its rabies vaccination (you will need to provide our office a copy of that rabies certificate). Copies of spay/neutering certificates will also be required for all new puppies/dogs if applicable. Those pet owners who are renewing their dog licenses from the previous year will only need to present us a spay/neutering certificate if the surgery for spay/neutering was done after you have registered your dog in 2023. We will also need a new/valid rabies certificate if it has expired. If you are unsure, you can always call our office to verify what documentation may be needed. If you no longer have a dog at your residence, you can call or email the office so we can remove you from our dog list.
